Field bindweed is found growing along nearly all Archuleta County right of ways. It is an aggressive competitor and often strangles other plants and its extensive root system makes it difficult to treat. Biological controls are available for the treatment of this species.

- *Convolvulus arvensis*
- Perennial
- Flowers are white or sometimes pink
- Extensive root system that may grow 10 feet deep and 30 feet laterally
- Tillage increases propagation
