



2022 Noxious Weed Revegetation Program

Available to private landowners with taxable land in Archuleta, Hinsdale & Mineral Counties

The San Juan Conservation District, in cooperation with Archuleta County Weed & Pest and CSU Extension Service, will provide a **FREE 5 lb. bag of Native Grass Seed or 1 lb. bag of Native Wildflower Seed** for every \$40 spent on treatment of approved weed species listed below, up to \$1,000 (25 bags of seed). Chemical expenses (purchased from Archuleta County) and any contracted spraying services are eligible for seed mix acquisition.

Seed mixes are limited! Submit an application early to reserve seed for fall pick up.
