



ORDINANCE NO. 2008- 1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE ARCHULETA COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 5-1990

WHEREAS, on November 30, 1990, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance No. 5-1990, which established speed limits for various streets in the Pagosa Lakes subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, some of the speed limits adopted in Ordinance No. 5-1990 no longer comply with state law (C.R.S. 42-4-1101) or the federal standards established in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; and

WHEREAS, uniform speed limits are established in C.R.S. 42-4-1101, unless a traffic investigation or study considering various specified factors justifies a deviation from the established speeds; and

WHEREAS, the speed limits in the remaining areas of Archuleta County conform with the state and federal standards.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ARCHULETA COUNTY, COLORADO THAT:


Section 1. Ordinance No. 5-1990, adopted on November 30, 1990, which established speed limits for various streets in the Pagosa Lakes subdivisions, is hereby repealed to the extent the specified speed limits conflict with those prescribed in C.R.S. 42-4-1101.


Section 2. The speed limits prescribed in C.R.S. 42-4-1101 or those supported by a traffic study in compliance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices shall hereafter be applied to the streets in the Pagosa Lakes subdivisions.
