V & T: their son and daughter in law has just passed inspections by SJBHD and the City for a new restaurant in town. They had an overall good experience with the inspectors. They were on time, professional acting, polite and specific. They were expensive. It cost \$400.00 now and then will be another \$400.00 in January for a year. They did not prorate. They had more problems with the City.

Realtor: Has a problem with getting ready for a closing and can not get a hold of SJBHD by phone and the office is closed with only a drop box for Septic permits. They take too long to respond.

Vets For Vets Mtg: out of 45 veterans at the meeting, one lady mentioned that she had a positive experience with the care and follow-up referrals for a child in her family with special needs. All other members had no other feedback except for Covid guidelines for Archuleta County should not be what LaPlata County is. The culture of the counties is so different.

## PUBLIC INPUT OF BUSINESS ASSOCIATED WITH SHBPH SERVICES AND MENTIONED IN THEIR BUDGET

AXIS: Ricardo offered information about the relationship with SJBHD. As of now, there is no need for SJBHD as they gave up Title 10 to them completely. AXIS is talking with them to see if they can utilize SJBHD building for allowing the High School teens to come in after school and utilize a telemedicine conference for health care needs. Right now they do birth control only for the teens. The contact person they have been talking to is Roselyn Penny at SJBHD.

DHS: Matt Dodson, Director of DHS offered the fact that they have had a “partnership intention” with SJBHD. CMP is no longer a program as it went to the schools. TANF is ongoing. WIC information is given. Vital statistic service is given. They do eligibility for Medicaid only. The Safecare program is ongoing. There are no contracts with SJBHD. Have Collaborative Management only. They give information about the Food Banks. Matt says the relationship has been good overall. There is no need for any additional or further services.

Pagosa Medical Center: Rhonda Ash offered information about their relationship with SJBHD. She is very pleased with the response of the Covid program and if she needs supplies they help her find them really fast. She says “ I am on overload with the immunization program. I give all kinds of immunizations 5 days a week.” She wishes SJBPH had more immunization clinics. Parents have a difficult time making appointments with SJBPH. They have to travel to Durango and the cost is too much. The Medical Center has no other services and no referrals made to or from SJBPH.

Archuleta County School District: Dr. Kym offered information about the relationship with SJBPH. She says she communicates with them weekly. On Thursday at noon they Zoom. The school does not make referrals. Their relationship is within the CDPHE requirements. SJBPH supports vaccine education. There is no in classroom education. They support and give information to teens re: healthy lifestyles, tips and safety information. If there is any further need, they call Oliver or Ryan at SJBPH.

Rise Above Violence: Carmen Hubb, Director offered information about SJBHD. She has actually trained employees at SJBHD as well as they have trained RAV employees. The cross training is about all there is. They are involved in age 0-5yr olds and do home visits. It is more of a collaborative relationship. There is no referrals made.
