To whom it may concern:

This letter indicates a commitment from the Board of County Commissioners of Archuleta County to allow Visionary Broadband usage of property owned by Archuleta County and located at 1122 Highway 84, Pagosa Springs, CO 81147 for the purposes of constructing and powering an approximately 60-foot tower adjacent to the County-owned building, installation of wireless broadband equipment and access to the fiber optic network node located at the same building. The tower, network elements and associated equipment on this property will be used to provide and expand access to high quality fixed wireless broadband in our rural area.

We commit to allow usage of any necessary easements, land access, and power access to Visionary Broadband in the event that Colorado's Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA) awards Visionary Broadband, in partnership with our local stakeholders, grant moneys from the Broadband Fund for such purposes. We have discussed preliminary costs and agreement templates for such structures and accesses and are ready to reach an agreement with Visionary based on negotiations preliminary to award funding. We are confident in Visionary's ability to provide excellent broadband in our areas where we are unserved or underserved and look forward to our future partnership.
