Dear Mr. Walls,

The Pagosa Springs Community Development Corporation is requesting the remaining funds that were allocated towards Broadband in 2019 by Archuleta County. To date, the County has paid the CDC \$25,000 of the \$100,000 committed. Therefore, we are requesting the remaining \$75,000.

Of this \$75,000, some of the money will be used towards the Broadband Service Managers and some towards the grant match which we hope to hear about soon. Should we not receive the DORA grant funding, this money will remain in a restrictive fund that will be used for broadband infrastructure projects or other matching grants which we will inform you about.

We are excited about being on a "tipping point" of finally seeing some progress in broadband efforts. The SCAN fiber is now open for access for independent ISPs and we have two leases. We hope to hear about the DORA funding soon. We will be starting on the Aspen Springs Monopole project, and we are working on the details of establishing a Carrier Neutral Location.

Thank you for your confidence in us as we work hard to move projects forward.
