

**ARCHULETA COUNTY PROCEEDINGS
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

The Board of County Commissioners held a Special Meeting on April 25, 2023, with County Commissioners Ronnie Maez, Warren Brown and Veronica Medina, County Attorney Todd Weaver and County Clerk and Recorder Kristy Archuleta present.

Chairman Maez called the Special Meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

New Business

A. Interviews with Applicants for County Coroner

Todd Weaver, County Attorney, stated the elected County Coroner resigned his position effective April 16, 2023 and an interim Coroner was appointed until a more permanent Coroner could be appointed. State Statute provides that the Board of County Commissioners shall be the body responsible for the appointment of an official to fill the vacancy of the unexpired term of an elected official. The Board received letters of interest to fill this vacancy and interviewed Shannon Balderas and Bradley Hunt.

Executive Session

A. Commissioner Brown moved to go into Executive Session pursuant to C.R.S. 24-6-402(4)(f) to discuss personnel matters related to the appointment of a replacement County Coroner. Commissioner Medina seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Chairman Maez announced that Commissioners Brown, Maez and Medina, and County Attorney Todd Weaver would be going into Executive Session. No decisions would be made.

Chairman Maez recessed the Special Meeting and convened the Executive Session at 2:00 p.m.

Chairman Maez adjourned Executive Session and reconvened the Special Meeting at 2:13 p.m.


New Business

Following the interviews, the Board of County Commissioners may appoint said permanent Coroner effective May 1, 2023. **Commissioner Medina moved to appoint Bradley Hunt as the County Coroner effective to serve until a coroner can be elected in the next general election in 2024. 
